

Sacrament of Matrimony

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

Is available the first Thursday of each month following the morning Mass or by calling the office 702.733.8323, if you are homebound. This sacrament brings God's strength to those who are ailing physically, mentally, emotionally or spiritually. In case of hospitalization, let the hospital staff know that you would like to have a Catholic priest see you.



Sharing the Grace of the Sacraments at St. Viator Catholic Community

Children are enrolled in faith formation classes throughout the academic year at St. Viator Catholic Community in Las Vegas. They work with Viatorians and parish catechists to prepare for the sacraments.



Along the way, unusual circumstances pop up and the need to readjust the timing for receiving the sacraments occurs. That was the case earlier this month when nine children, already enrolled in classes preparing them for first Communion and confirmation, were baptized.

Associate Deacon Mike Underwood was on hand to baptize the children. He now is in his fourth year helping out at St. Viator.

"It was an absolute blessing to be able to baptize these children into the church and an inspiration to see how well prepared and excited they all were to receive their first sacrament," Deacon Mike said. "I look forward to walking with them and their families as they continue to grow in their faith."

As a full time member of the parish ministry staff, Deacon Mike expected to assist at Masses, visit the sick and officiate at baptisms, funerals and weddings. But over the last three years he has done so much more.

"He's been indispensable," says Fr. Richard Rinn, CSV, Pastor.

Associate Rosy Hartz serves as Director of the Faith Formation Program and she too finds the willingness of Deacon Mike to serve, indispensable. "Deacon Mike is

a treasured help when it comes to accommodating families," she says.

Receiving the sacrament, privately and ahead of his classmates was arranged when it was discovered that his godfather would be deployed in April.

The baptisms took place out of a desire by the children's families to have them fully welcomed into the Catholic faith. The sacrament of baptism is one of three sacraments of initiation, that includes baptism, confirmation and the Eucharist.

"Families want them to know their faith," Rosy says, "and we welcome those of all ages to come to age appropriate classes so they can prepare for the sacraments."

DECLINE TO SIGN!

In preparation for Nevada's November 2024 general election, there are two abortion related ballot initiatives for which signatures either have been or are currently being collected, that propose to enshrine abortion into our Nevada Constitution.

The Nevada Catholic Conference opposes these constitutional amendments, and the efforts seeking to permanently place the right to abortion in our state constitution, because:

- It dangerously expands abortion rights. Abortion, already legal in Nevada up to 24 weeks of pregnancy, would now be permitted to the 9th month of pregnancy, to full term.
- It removes parental notification, consent, and family involvement from all reproductive decisions for their minor children, including abortion and the treatment of issues such as gender dysphoria.
- <u>It eliminates the 'licensed physician' requirement for abortion</u> and substitutes 'health care practitioner' that could include nurses, physical therapists, dieticians, and athletic trainers (NRS 629.031) which would be dangerous to women in Nevada.

For these and many other reasons, the Nevada Catholic Conference urges all - Decline to Sign!



A protestant pastor friend of mine was invited to meet Pope Francis with a group of other pastors. He noticed the Pope's chair was especially ornate and set at the head of the group. He somewhat playfully said, "Holy Father, why do *you* get that special chair?" The group chuckled nervously at my friend's audacious chide.

The following year, the group was invited to return. They entered the room to find only simple chairs placed in a circle. Pope Francis entered, sat down in one of the humble chairs and, looking directly at my friend, with a twinkle in his eye, asked, "What do you think of my chair now?" My friend was stunned that the Pope remembered his concerns — and took the time to answer them.



Thomas the apostle was certainly stunned by the Risen Jesus displaying his wounds in person. But he also must have been equally shocked that Jesus knew and answered his particular questions, worries, and even demands related to his faith. How humbled — and perhaps a bit terrified — he must have been to realize God remembers his concerns and cares enough to answer them.

What questions or demands about Jesus do you find in your heart? Like Thomas, will you be bold enough to voice them this week? How wonderful to know that if we do so, God will remember and respond even to our most audacious desires.

Written in the Wounds

For all the condemnation Thomas the Doubter has received in 2000 years of homilies, I think there's something to admire in him.

Thomas is not unique. We all waver at some point, overcome by hesitation, distracted by the clamor of the world which seeks at every turn to shout above the whisper of the divine.

Thomas knows what he saw on Good Friday: his friend nailed to a cross, a sword driven through his body. He saw the blood and the water. He saw these things with his own eyes, eyes given to him by God, eyes which have never failed him before. And God doesn't ask us to suspend reality to believe in Him. He only asks us to be discerning about how that reality is interpreted in our hearts.

Thomas knows the man before him is either a fraud, preying on the hopes and anxieties of the traumatized disciples, or he is the Christ, the Savior of the world, accomplisher of impossible things. But where to look, to tell the difference?

Satan once appeared to the great mystic saint, Teresa of Avila, disguised as Jesus. She knew instantly that he was a fraud. Enraged, he demanded to know where his deception had failed. "You have no wounds," she told him simply.

Could we have accepted a savior who did not bleed? I don't think we could, because sooner or later, we would all stand before him and say, "Here is where the world hurt me. Here, and here, and here. What about you?" Christ can point to his hands, his feet, his side. "Here, and here, and here," he can say. "And I overcame them all."

It's the wounds, you see. The truth is in the wounds.

Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!"


